The Hirer Indemnifies Cairns Castles and Entertainment

- a) Against any injury to any person or persons, or loss of (including lawful confiscation), damage to or destruction of the jumping castle, irrespective of how the injury, loss, damage or destruction is caused.
- b) Against, and must pay to Cairns Castles and Entertainment on demand, any goods and services tax payable on or in connection with this Agreement and/or any Hire Fees or other money paid or payable under this agreement.
- c) Against any loss, liability or damage Cairns Castles and Entertainment suffers because of a breach or repudiation of this agreement by the hirer.

If you have not selected the option to have CCAE (Cairns Castles and Entertainment) staff to supervise for the duration of your hire, you accept full liability, responsibility and agree to adhere to all CCAE safety procedures.

CCAЕ accepts no liability in any form if the hirer opts to not have CCAE staff to supervise.

All person using CCAE equipment do so at their own risk. Unsupervised or reckless behaviour can result in injury.

It is the hirers responsibility to ensure compliance with CCAE Safety procedures.

The hirer is responsible for any damages caused to CCAE equipment.

Jumping Castles

1. The hirer is responsible for providing an 18+ supervisor at all times. The supervisor must not be under the influence of medication, drugs or alcohol and at all times have a clear view of children and must never leave the castle/s unattended.
2. In the event of a power or mechanical failure of the blower and the castle begins to deflate the supervisor must immediately remove all children from castle and double check all children have been accounted for, no children are to go back on the castle until problem is rectified and castle has been correctly reinflated and inspected by supervisor, this applies when inflating and deflating castle.
3. In the advent of adverse weather conditions, the supervisor is required to make a judgement call as to whether it is safe for children to be on castle and whether it needs to be deflated, operations must cease if, wind increases over 25knots, rain of any kind or extreme heat, in the advent of rain, it is the supervisor's responsibility to secure the blower and leads from getting wet.
4. If at any time the anchor ropes or ground pegs look loose operations must cease until these have been resecured.
5. Children are not to play at the rear of castles where blower and leads are operating and the area where the blowers are situated is to be kept free of rubbish that could get sucked into blower air intake.

6. There is to be no smoking on or near the castle and such things as BBQ's and fire pits or any other form of heat generation is to be kept away from castle, also no food, drinks, or foreign objects are to be on the castle.
7. Persons with injuries and medical conditions should not participate on the castles.
8. No overcrowding, children should be grouped to size and ages to prevent injuries and children should not be allowed to climb or sit on walls of castles and netting.
9. Age 4-14yrs only.
10. For children with special needs please contact CCAE.
11. To prevent friction burns children should all be fully clothed and wearing socks and no shoes, glasses or hats to be worn.
12. No pets
13. If the supervisor observes any children behaving in a rough boisterous manner that may put themselves or other children at risk of injury, they are to be removed from castle this includes flips and hand stands and running or charging.
14. No loitering at the bottom of slides and no jumping on safety steps and from top of slides
15. Damage, there is a \$500 damage fee to damages to castle and \$250 damage fee to blowers.
16. Cleaning, there is a \$100 cleaning fee if the castle is left with mud, dirt or sand on it.
17. Cancellations:
CCAЕ: If CCAE determines that weather is unacceptable for safe operations, then we reserve the right to cancel the booking at any time and a full refund will be provided.
If the job has not been cancelled & CCAE staff have set foot on the premise, no refund will be given.
Client: If a client cancels < 5 days notice, no refund is given.

Party Hire Equipment

1. The hirer is to either themselves or have a nominated supervisor 18+ to monitor and operate equipment.
2. All party hire and electrical equipment must at all times be kept in a safe and dry area.
3. Please adhere to the operating and safety procedures on card attached to each piece of equipment.
4. No smoking, food, drinks of any kind near equipment.
5. Damage fee is \$250 dollars per piece of equipment.
